CORNER NOT REMONUMENTED

From this corner, a nail in power pole No. 159030,
bears N. 85° 06' E., 3.49 chs. dist.

From this same corner, a nail in power pole No. 159031,
bears N. 71° 25' W., 1.11 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the SE. corner of a ranch house,
bears N. 49° 58' W., 2.49 chs. dist.

From this same corner, a well and pump, bears N. 18°
18' W., 2.01 chs. dist.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by
A. Lash, Jr., U.S. Deputy Surveyor
in 1868.

The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, monumented with a
railroad spike, set flush with the surface of the
pavement, 0.078 chs. W. of the center line of U.S.
Highway No. 95 A, as shown on State of Nevada
Department of Highway's Right-of-Way Map, County-Lyon,
Route-2B. Sec.-A. This position has been recognized by
land surveyors and is accepted as a careful and
faithful perpetuation of the position of the original
corner.

CORNER NOT REMONUMENTED

from which

A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins.
diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference
monument, bears S. 78° 55' E., 58.0 lks. dist.,
with brass cap mkd. T14N R25E S 22 RM 38.3 FT.
1988 and an arrow pointing to the true corner.

A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins.
diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference
monument, bears S. 68° 07' W., 58.0 lks. dist.,
with brass cap mkd. T14N R25E S 21 RM 38.3 FT.
1988 and an arrow pointing to the true corner.

N. 0° 25' E., bet. secs. 15 and 16.

Over nearly level land, along U.S. Highway No. 95 A.

Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, at
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence
of the original corner.

Set a railroad spike, flush with the surface of U.S.
Highway No. 95 A.
