| 41.22 | <p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, monumented with a brass cap cemented flush with the surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd., ¼ S25 S30 T14S R65E R66E 1979 RE 2002, and with a wooden post, 4 ins. square, firmly set showing 4 ft. above the ground alongside. This brass cap is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Add the marks BLM 1987 to the brass cap.</p> |

This aluminum cap is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Add the marks BLM 1987 to the aluminum cap.</p> |
