Preble, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1875.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 31 and 36, Tps. 33 N., Rs. 30 and 31 E., on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a slate stone, 30X12X6 ins., plainly mkd. with 6 notches on the N., E. and W. edges, loosely set in a mound of stone.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T33N R30E R31E S 36 S 31 <hr style="width: 50px; margin: auto;"/>S 6 T32N R31E</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Deposit the original cornerstone alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>From this corner, U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "PLACERITAS," monumented with a standard tablet stamped PLACERITAS 1935, firmly set in concrete, bears S. 81° 06.6' W., (mean bearing) 466.88 chs. dist.</p> <p>N. 0° 58' E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush, native grass and juniper.</p>
5.00	Ravine, drains W.
35.70	Ridge, bears NW. and SE.
