Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by H. E. Franks and
J. S. Mullen, U.S. Deputy Surveyors in 1904.

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a redwood post, 4 ins. square, 18 ins. long, with illegible scribe marks visible, firmly set 16 ins. in the ground, with a water pipe, 2 ins. diam., 36 ins. long, firmly set 24 ins. in the ground alongside.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Reset the original wooden post and the water pipe inverted alongside the stainless steel post.
