40.104	<p>N. 0° 00.2' W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through scattered greasewood and native grass.</p> <p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, monumented with a redwood post, 4 ins. square, 36 ins. long, with illegible scribe marks visible, firmly set 18 ins. in the ground, with a basalt stone, 3X2X2 ins., plainly mkd. with an "X" set at the base of post.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T14N R27E ¼ S 61S 5  1989</p> <p>Reset the original wooden post and the marked stone alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
