DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST BOUNDARY, T. 19 S., R. 61 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by R. H. Woods and W. H. Myrick, U.S. Deputy Surveyors in 1881.

The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a metal cap cemented in a concrete monument, 6 ins. diam., set flush with the ground, mkd. T19S R60ER61E S19 S24 S25 S30 RE 290. This metal cap correlates well with other existing original corners and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Add the marks BLM 1990 to the cap.

From this corner, an aluminum cap cemented in a concrete monument, 10 ins. diam., set flush with the ground, mkd. City of Las Vegas BM No., bears S. 82° 26' E., 4.094 chs. dist.

From this same corner, a rebar, 1/2 in. diam., firmly set and exposed 3 ins. above the ground, with aluminum cap mkd., V.T.N. RLS 6201, bears S.  $82^{\circ}$  01' E., 3.901 chs. dist.

From this same corner, a rebar, 5/8 in. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above the ground, with metal tag attached, mkd. RLS 2050, bears S.  $76^{\circ}$  30' E., 0.026 chs. dist.

From this same corner, a nail cemented in a concrete monument, 6 ins. diam., set 4 ins. below the surface of the ground, bears S. 76° 22′ E., 5.292 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., Rs. 60 and 61 E., monumented with an aluminum cap, cemented 6 ins. below the surface of Decatur Blvd. and Lone Mountain Road, (paved), mkd. RLS 6201, bears S. 0° 18.2' W., 164.79 chs. dist.

N. 0° 19.4' E., bet. secs. 19 and 24.

Over nearly level land, through scattered creosote and shadscale.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
