20.119	<p>Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p>S 1/16 S 1 S 6</p> <p>1990</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
23.70	Enter flood plain of Las Vegas Wash, bears NW. and SE.
32.70	Leave flood plain of Las Vegas Wash, bears NW. and SE.
36.00	Enter wash area, drains SSE.
