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T. 20 S., R. 54 E., MDM, NEVADA CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 20 South, Range 54 East, is nearly level to gently rolling. The elevation ranges from about 2,670 to 2,990 ft. above sea level. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, creosote and cacti. The soil is sandy in the southern portion and rocky in the northern portion. Access into the area is provided by Nevada State Route No. 160, which crosses through sections 29 and 32 from NW. to SE. Other access is provided by numerous paved and secondary roads. There is a gravel pit in the southeast quarter of section 29. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
