(RUBY VALLEY GUIDE MERIDIAN),
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 55 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	<p>A ponderosa pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N. $56\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 16 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 on partially healed blaze. (Record, S. $61\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 94 lks.)</p> <p>A stump hole, bears S. 73° E., 57 lks. dist., with a down ponderosa pine alongside, 28 ins. diam., mkd. WC $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT on open blaze.
