	<p>Over nearly level meadowland.</p>
7.60	<p>Cottonwood Creek, 50 lks. wide, course NW.</p>
9.30	<p>Fence, bears N. and S.</p>
40.415	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p>
	<p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
