<p>40.18</p>	<p>From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.</p> <p>N. 89° 01' W., bet. secs. 2 and 11.</p> <p>Over rolling land, covered with scattered juniper, sagebrush, rabbitbrush, native grass and sparse cactus.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 11, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T30N R55E ¼ S 2 S 11</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Set a wooden post, 3 ins. diam., 4 ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>The corner is located 71 lks. S. of a fence bearing E. and W.</p>
<p>60.30</p> <p>80.36</p>	<p>Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.</p> <p>N. 0° 34' E., bet. secs. 2 and 3.</p> <p>Over rolling land, covered with scattered juniper, sagebrush, rabbitbrush, native grass and sparse cactus.</p>
