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	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The land within the confines of this survey in Township 39 North, Range 62 East, located on the western slope of the Snake Mountains, is approximately 6,000 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The soil consists of sandy clay, gravelly and rocky, and the vegetation includes sagebrush, cheatgrass and native grass.
	There are several washes in the area draining primarily westerly. There are a few trail roads which cross the area and principal users are cattlemen.
	No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the resurvey.
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
