

## TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 68 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 1 South, Range 68 East, is mostly mountainous except for some pastures in small areas of Condor Canyon and more extensive areas in section 13. The elevation ranges from about 4,900 to 5,400 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam in the pasture areas to rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, Brigham tea, bitterbrush, cacti, rabbitbrush, live oak and native grass. There are scattered stands of willows and cottonwood trees along the creek that flows in the bottom of Condor Canyon. Some scattered juniper are to be found on the bench lands above Condor Canyon. The abandoned roadbed of the Union Pacific Railroad follows the bottom of Condor Canyon. Delmues ranch with many buildings is located in the northeast part of section 13. There is an abandoned stone sawmill building in section 27 in Condor Canyon.</p> <p>The principal users of the area are people grazing cattle. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
