

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 65 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

81.30 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.

81.67 The cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., monumented with a rebar, 5/8 in. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of corner. This mound of stone and rebar is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and is identical with the BLM tellurometer traverse station shown on Nevada Protraction Diagram No. 28, Unit No. 109. This corner will now refer to Tps. 13 and 14 S., Rs. 65 E. only.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Reset the rebar inside the stainless steel post and rebuild the mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this corner, a U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station, monumented with a standard brass tablet firmly set in concrete, with brass tablet mkd. "MUDDY RIVER," bears S. 58° 50' E., (mean bearing), 296.03 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 14 South, Range 65 East, is situated about 5 miles west of Moapa, Nevada. The main access into the area is via Nevada State Highway No. 168. There are numerous improved jeep trails throughout the township. The area resurveyed varies from rolling to mountainous. The elevation ranges from 2,200 to 3,200 ft. above sea level. The soil is rocky in the higher elevations to sandy and gravelly in the washes. The vegetation consists of creosote, chaparral brush, yucca, Cholla and pricklypear cactus and stands of cat claw and mesquite trees along the washes.
