79.88	<p>Point for the cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., determined latitudinally at proportionate distance bet. the cor. of Tps. 15 and 16 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., and the cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 S., R. 65 E., and longitudinally at record distance from the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, Tps. 14 and 15 S., R. 65 E.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This corner will now refer to Tps. 14 and 15 S., R. 65 E. only.</p>
