From the W-E 1/64 of secs. 1 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 15 S., R. 65 E., executed under Group No. 638.

N. 0° 20' E., on the N-S center line of the SW¼ of the SE¼ of sec. 36.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 15 South, Range 65 East, is situated about 40 miles northeast of Las Vegas, Nevada. The main access into the area is via U.S. Interstate Highway No. 15. There are numerous unimproved jeep trails throughout the township. The area surveyed and resurveyed varies from mountainous in the northwest portion to rolling in the remainder of the township. The elevation ranges from about 1,800 to 3,100 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky in the higher elevations to sandy and gravelly in the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of creosote and chaparrill brush, barrel, yucca, Cholla and pricklypear cactus, scattered Joshua trees and stands of mesquite trees along the washes. California wash enters the township in section 35 and exits in section 24.
