

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF
THE EAST BOUNDARY,
T. 15 S., R. 63 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner, the NW. cor. of T. 16 S., R. 64 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the N. bdy of T. 16 S., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 89° 43' W., 17.65 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the true point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 16 S., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 317, bears SOUTH, 34.53 chs. dist.

From which

The witness cor. for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 16 S., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 317, bears South, 5.80 chs. dist. Hereafter, this corner will function as an amended monument.

Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.

From the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines, T. 16 S., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 317. Remark the brass cap to read as follows:
