Hereafter, this corner will function as an amended monument.</p> <p>Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>Point for the true point for the E $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 at the intersection with the W. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., and the E. and W. centerline of sec. 1.</p> <p>From this point, point selected for the witness corner for the E $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, bears N. $0^{\circ} 12'$ W., 6.06 chs. dist.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>WC T16S R63E R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 ↓ 1987</p> </div> <p>From this point, the true point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 16 S., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. $0^{\circ} 12'$ E., 5.39 chs. dist.</p> <p>From which</p> <p>The witness cor. for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 16 S., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. $2^{\circ} 52'$ E., 4.05 chs. dist.</p> <p>From this same point, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 16 S., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 317, bears S. $89^{\circ} 59'$ W.
