5.34	<p>The standard closing cor. of T. 16 S., R. 63 E. and T. 17 S., R. 64 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, through Range 63 East, executed under this same Group.</p>
40.00	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This corner will now refer to sec. 31 only.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T16S R63E R64E ¼ S 31</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1987</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
45.32	<p>The E ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 16 S., R. 63 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 16 S., R. 63 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p>
