CHAINS	<p>From this same corner, the closing cor. of secs. 11 and 12, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 S., R. 64 E., executed under Group No. 237, bears NORTH, 5.44 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.</p> <p>Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.</p> <p>From which</p> <p>The standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, through Range 64 East, executed under Group. No. 237, bears WEST, 14.15 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.</p> <p>Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>Point for the N $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 12 at the intersection with the Fourth Standard Parallel South and the N - S center line of sec. 12.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T16S R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 T17S R64E</div><div>1987</div></div> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5$\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>From this corner, the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, through Range 64 East, executed concurrently under this same Group, bears EAST, 9.77 chs. dist.</p> <p>From this same corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 S., R. 64 E., executed under Group No. 237, bears SOUTH.
