

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 65 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

From this same corner, the closing cor. of Tps. 17 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set showing 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the east boundary of T. 17 S., R. 64 E., executed under Group No. 237, bears N. 0° 01' W., 5.47 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.

Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.

The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set showing 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, executed under Group No. 237, bears WEST, 14.16 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.

Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.

Point for the N $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7, is at intersection with the Fourth Standard Parallel South and the N. and S. center line of sec. 7.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner, the standard cor. of Tps. 16 S., Rs. 64 and 65 E., monumented with an aluminum post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, through Range 65 East, executed under Group No. 638, bears EAST, 12.14 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 S., R. 65 E., executed under Group No. 373, bears S. 0° 04' E.

Remark the brass cap to read as follows:
