

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 65 EAST, MDM. NEVADA

CHAINS

From this same corner, the N $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7, monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 S., R. 65 E., executed under Group No. 373, bears N. 0° 04' W., 5.40 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.

Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.

The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 16 S., R. 64 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South, executed under Group No. 237, bears WEST, 11.78 chs. dist. Hereafter, this cor. will function as an amended monument.

Add the marks "AM 1987" to the brass cap.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within the confines of the survey in Township 17 South, Range 65 East, is located south of the Moapa Indian Reservation and is nearly level to gently rolling desert land, the mean elevation is about 2,000 ft. above sea level. There are several small washes draining southerly. The soil is sandy clay loam and the vegetation is mostly desert chaparral, creosote and cacti.

Access into the area is provided by Interstate No. 15.
