63.30	Fence, bears NE. and SW.
79.30	Ravine, drains W.
80.000	Point for the cor. of secs. 25 and 36.
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
