Soft Snap lode

From Cor. No. 1 of M.S. No. 3992, Soft Snap lode, identical with Cor. No. 13 of East Mountain City Townsite, monumented with a concrete block, 6 ins. square, firmly set, 6 ins. under the surface of the ground, with brass cap, 3 ins. diam., mkd. EMTCT No. 13 1940.

CORNER NOT REMONUMENTED

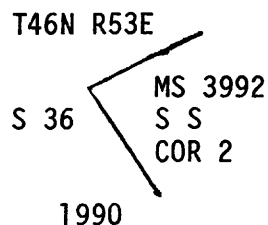
Thence N. 35° 27' W., along line 1-2 of M.S. No. 3992, Soft Snap lode identical with line 13-12, East Mountain City Townsite.

1.169 Cor. No. 12 of East Mountain City Townsite, hereinafter described.

Continuing measurement, along line
 1-2 of M.S. No. 3992, Soft Snap lode.

9.238 Point for Cor. No. 2 of M.S. No. 3992, Soft Snap lode, determined by the method of parallel end and side lines; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.

Thence N. 43° 14' E.
