Left bank, Owyhee River, bears irregularly NW. and SE.; thence 8.00 across water course NW. 9.00 Right bank, Owyhee River, bears irregularly NW. and SE. Point for Cor. No. 7 of H.E.S. No. 39, determined at record 9.453 distance from 1936 Department of Highways, State of Nevada plans for Highway 11A (now 225) and rotating the 1936 bearings 30 minutes to the left to agree with the East Mountain City Townsite bearings where there is a common line on published data between Cor. Nos. 11 and 12 of H.E.S. No. 39, identical with Cor. Nos. 9 and 8, respectively, of East Mountain City Townsite; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
