

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

CHAINS	<p>The land enclosed in this survey is located around the town of Mountain City, Nevada. The terrain is mostly rolling with limited level hay meadows along the Owyhee River which enters the section a little east of the south $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner, meanders in a northerly and westerly direction, and leaves the section at a point south of the northwest corner of sec. 36. The elevation ranges from about 5,600 to 6,100 feet above sea level. The soil varies from clay loam and rocky in the higher elevations to loam in the bottom land. Access is provided by several trail roads feeding into paved Nevada State Highway No. 225 which parallels the east side of the Owyhee River. Undergrowth consists of willows, aspen, sagebrush, rose bushes and native grass. There are other types of surveys in this section consisting of mineral surveys, homestead entry surveys and a townsite survey. The city dump and sewer treatment area are located in the south half of the section and on the west side of the Owyhee River. Mining activity is to be found throughout the section.</p> <hr/>
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
