

## TOWNSHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

## CHAINS

The vertical angles of measurements made on the slope were ascertained with a theodolite in good adjustment; the horizontal equivalents only are entered in the field notes.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is at latitude  $40^{\circ} 45' 43.0''$  N. and longitude  $118^{\circ} 25' 38.4''$  W., (NAD 27), as calculated along section lines from U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "VABM 4488 (USGS)."

The mean magnetic declination was found to be  $16^{\circ}$  E.

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Reestablishment of the Resurvey Executed by

in 1912.

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The cor. of Tps. 33 and 34 N., Rs. 31 and 32 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 8 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 32 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

Corner is located at end of a fence bearing N.

N.  $89^{\circ} 49'$  W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 31 E., executed under Group No. 14.
