## **CHAINS**

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, exposed 12 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 34 N., R. 31 E., executed under Group No. 14.

Remark the brass cap to read as follows:

S. 89° 55' E., bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass.

Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 7, T. 34 N., R. 32 E.

Point for the closing cor. of the NE. cor. of sec. 12, T. 34 N., R. 31 E.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Set a steel fence post,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.

From this corner, the NW. cor. of sec. 7, T. 34 N., R. 32 E., monumented with a stainless steel post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set, exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 32 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 1° 30' W., 7.89 chs. dist.
