41.08	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Hereafter this corner will refer to the W $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 only.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T34N R31E R32E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31</p> <p>1988</p> </div> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
