40.94	<p>N. 0° 44' W., across sec. 1, T. 34 N., R. 31 E.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass.</p> <p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Hereafter this corner will function as an amended monument.</p> <p>Set a copper-coated steel stake, 18 ins. long, $\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AM</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>From this same corner, the W $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, established at the intersection of the E-W center line of sec. 6, on the E. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 34 N, R. 31 E., bears N. 89° 00' E., 13.13 chs. dist.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T34N R31E R32E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>From this corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, hereinafter described, bears N. 89° 00' E.</p>
