	<p>From the cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.</p>
	<p>S. 89° 42' W., bet. secs. 17 and 20.</p>
	<p>Over rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush and native grass.</p>
	<p>Trail road, bears NE. and SW.</p>
	<p>Wash, 50 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NE.</p>
	<p>Ridge, bears N. and S.</p>
	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 20, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p>
	<p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
