	N. 0° 20' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.  Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass.
20.50	Enter nearly level land.
40.10	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.  <div style="text-align: center;"> T34N  R32E R33E  <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>  S 1   S 6    1987 </div> Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.
65.40	Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.
80.20	Point for the cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 32 and 33 E., at proportionate distance, based on the 1875 survey; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Hereafter this corner will refer to Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 33 E., and Tps. 34 and $34\frac{1}{2}$ N., Rs. 32 E. only.
