80.56	<p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T35N R33E S 23 S 24</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, monumented with the decayed remains of a willow post, with illegible scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T35N R33E S 14 S 13 S 23 S 24</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Reset the decayed remains of the original wooden post and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>

S. 88° 30' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 13.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with medium shadscale, native grass, scattered Brigham tea, white sage, sagebrush and rabbitbrush.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This corner will now refer to the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 13 only.</p>
