Soil, silty alkali to sandy loam. Undergrowth, shadscale, halogeten, sagebrush and native grass.</p> <hr/> <p>Point for the N ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 35, is at midpoint bet. closing corners and on the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 36 N., R. 33 E.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T36N R33E</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 T35½N R33E </p> <p style="text-align: center;">1988</p> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>From this corner, the standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 36 N., R. 33 E., hereinbefore described, bears N. 89° 47' E., 16.865 chs. dist.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 35 N., R. 33 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p> <p>NORTH, bet. secs. 33 and 34.</p>
