

SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 34 N., R. 33½ E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, T. 34 N., R. 33 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 33 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 1° 39' W., 7.24 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the E ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 24, T. 34 N., R. 33 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 33 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. 1° 39' E., 36.09 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam and rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and native grass.

Point for the W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 24, is WEST of the E ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 24, and on the E. bdy. of sec. 24, T. 34 N., R. 33 E.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
