	Over nearly level land, covered with scattered whitesage, shadscale and native grass.
40.52	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
