

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
TOWNSHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 51 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 34 North, Range 51 East, is mostly rolling, with mountains in the southeast portion and nearly level along the creek bottoms. The elevation ranges from about 5,140 to 5,900 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and rocky on the higher elevations to black loam along the creeks. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush and native grass.

Maggie Creek and Simon Creek drain the area, crossing the township from N. to S.

Access into the township is provided by a paved road and numerous secondary and desert trail roads. Principal users of the township are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
