Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
P. K. Russell, Cadastral Surveyor in 1957.

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, monumented with an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 21 S., R. 59 E., executed under Group No. 642. Add marks 1992 to brass cap.

N.  $0^{\circ} 46.2'$  W., on a portion of the N-S center line of sec. 6.

Over rolling land.

17.00 Wash, 2 chs. wide, drains SE.

19.70 Paved road, 70 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

20.789 Point for the C-S  $\frac{1}{16}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd.

Add marks 1992 to brass cap.
