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	From the C-S $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6.
	N. $86^{\circ} 38.4'$ W., on the E-W center line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 6.
5.70	Wash, 70 lks. wide, drains SE.
9.90	Gravel road, 70 lks. wide, bears N. and S.
19.513	The SW $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, identical with Angle Point No. 6, Parcel C, sec. 6.
27.40	Ascend over steep rocky NE. slope.

<p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p>
