TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 59 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The geographic position of the SE. cor. of sec. 11, is at latitude $36^{\circ} 02' 27.0''$ N. and longitude $115^{\circ} 19' 57.8''$ W., (NAD 27), as calculated along section lines from a direct tie to State of Nevada, Department of Highways, Station "538-50," identical with U.S.G.S. triangulation station.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 14° E., as noted on $7\frac{1}{2}$ minute U.S.G.S. topographic map, Blue Diamond SE, Nevada, (1983 edition).

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
T. 22 S., R. 59 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by J. M. Brunt and W. H. Proctor, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881, and the Resurvey Executed by H. G. Parker, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1956-58.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 22 S., R. 58 E., executed under Group No. 365. Add the marks "T22S R58E R59E 1989" to the brass cap.

N. $0^{\circ} 36'$ E., bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Over mountainous land, covered with scattered yucca, cacti, creosote brush, willows, Brigham tea and native grass.

27.20 Right bank of deep wash, bears NNW. and SSE.

29.00 Left bank of wash, bears NNW. and SSE.

38.00 Paved road, NSR 159, bears WNW. and ESE.

40.57 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
