GENERAL DESCRIPTION The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 12 North, Range 60 East, varies from gently rolling to rolling. The elevation ranges from about 6,200 to 6,300 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass. There is scattered juniper throughout the area. There are three buildings located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 9 and the White River crosses the section from NW. to SE. Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the section is provided by numerous improved and unimproved desert trail roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
