CHAINS	<p>Set a steel fence post, 5$\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>From this corner, station No. 3, on the Moapa Indian Reservation, hereinbefore described, bears N. 54° 22.0' W., 19.423 chs. dist.</p>

GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
<p>The area resurveyed and surveyed within Township 14 South, Range 65 East, is situated about 3 miles west of the town of Moapa, Nevada. The elevation varies from about 1,600 to 1,800 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay and rocky. The vegetation consists of creosote, shadscale, chaparral and cacti. The terrain is broken by washes draining into the Muddy River which crosses the area in a southeasterly direction.</p> <p>Access into the area is provided by many streets and improved and unimproved, bladed and desert trail roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
