	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area resurveyed within Township 45 North, Range 30 East, varies from mountainous in the west portion to gently rolling and rolling in the eastern portion. The elevation ranges from about 4,600 to 6,800 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush, greasewood and native grass.
	Alta Creek, drains east southeast through the central portion of the township.
	Access into the township is provided by Nevada State Route No. 140, which enters on the east boundary of section 12 and leaves on the north boundary of section 1 and numerous other improved and unimproved desert trail roads.
	Principal users of the area are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
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
