<p>CHAINS 84.90</p>	<p>The standard cor. of Tps. 46 N., Rs. 30 and 31 E., identical with U.S.G.S. triangulation station, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd., as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey in T. 45 N., R. 30 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 46 North, Range 31 East, ranges from about 4,600 to 4,700 ft. above sea level and is mostly rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay, gravelly and rock. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by numerous improved and unimproved desert trail roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <hr/>
