GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land encompassed in this survey is located about twenty-two miles north of the old mining town of Belmont, Nevada in Nye County and in the Toquima Range.

The land is mountainous and is drained by series of ravines and washes that drain southeasterly into Monitor Valley. The elevation ranges from 7,600 ft. above sea level near the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, in East Northumberland Canyon to 8,200 ft. above sea level near the NE. cor. of the Tp.

The soil is composed of rocks and clay loam. The timber consists of pinion pine, juniper, and mountain mahogany. The undergrowth consists of sagebrush and native grass.

Access into the area is by way of improved roads and with numerous trail roads.

There were no mineral deposits or mining activity noted along the lines of the survey.
