Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a mound of stone, 3 1/2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A lodgepole pine, 35 ins. diam., bears N. 2° W., 49 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S31 BT.

Cor. is located on gradual NW slope in logged area, and is 4 chs. S of the end of jeep trail, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 10° W.

49.403 Intersect the California-Nevada State Line at a point N. 0°41'10" E., 34.008 chs. from Milepost 187.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 16 and 17 N., R. 18 E., Nevada.
