

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,  
T. 16 N., R. 18 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, CALIFORNIA

Chains

From this point the original closing cor. bears S. 89°17'00" W., 0.087 chs. dist., perpetuated with an unmarked iron rod, 3/4 in. diam., in "rock mound", as described on 3 RS 50, (sheet 1 of 3 sheets), recorded by E.R. Reding, LS 3192, in May 1969. There is no evidence of the LS 3192 SW cor. of sec. 7 or of the closing cor. described on 9 RS 123, recorded November 1984 by LS 4332.

Note: From the true point for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, an aluminum pipe, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. diam., 1/2 ft. high, with U.S.D.A. aluminum cap mkd. T16N S1 R17E T16N S7 CC S18 R18E LS 4332 1984 (as per 9 RS 123), bears South, 0.013 chs. dist. This monument was established by improper procedure, and is utilized by this resurvey to function only as an accessory or reference to the true cor. position.

From the true point for the closing cor., the local bearing trees

A Jeffrey pine, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 73 3/4° E., 60 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks T16N R18E S18 CC BT.

A white fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 44° E., 61 lks. dist., with scribe marks T16N R18E S18 CC BT.

From this point the cor. of secs. 1 and 12 only, T. 16 N., R. 17 E., bears S. 0°01'50" E., 2.793 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

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From the angle point bet. secs. 6 and 7, on the original 1865 Ives Range Line (interim W bdy. of the Tp.), hereinbefore described.

S. 89°51'10" E., bet. secs. 6 and 7.

The closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, on the California-Nevada State Line, monumented with an iron rod, 5/8 in. diam., projecting 8 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. diam., 1/2 ft. high, with metal tag attached and stamped RCE 15814, described on Plat of Kingsview, recorded by John C. Lichliter in May 1969, in Book 1 of Maps, at Page 58, in Placer County, California records, and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original cor.

There were no bearing trees reported in the original survey.

Not remonumented.
