

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 64 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 18 South, Range 64 East, is rolling to mountainous. The elevation varies from 2,000 to 2,400 feet above sea level. The vegetation consists of creosote brush and cholla. The soil varies from sandy clay, rocky and gravelly.

The Union Pacific Railroad and Interstate Highway No. 15, crosses north northeasterly through the area.

No mineral formations of consequences were noted during the survey.
