	<p><b>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</b></p> <p>The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 20 South, Range 57 East, is mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 5,840 to 8,000 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky and the vegetation consists of cacti, Brigham tea, manzanita, sagebrush and scrub oak. There is mahogany, juniper, and pinion pine throughout the township.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by the Lovell Canyon and Trout Creek Roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <hr/>
