From the cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., Rs. 22 and 23 E., recovered in
1925 under Group No. 101, monumented with a standard iron post,
(not of record), 3 ins. diam., firmly set exposed 6 ins. above
ground, with brass cap mkd.

N. 89° 56' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass.

9.00 Ravine, drains SE.

19.50 Trail road, bears N. and S.

40.54 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with a granite
stone, 5x4x2 ins., plainly mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$, lying loose on the ground.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post,
